However, in order to ensure a very high standard of papers, we advise **that some papers will be rejected even after they have been provisionally accepted**. To avoid this happening to your paper, please ensure all the points below have been fulfilled.

- 1) You make the **corrections as suggested by the reviewers**. The reviews can be found on the EDAS website. NB some papers do not require corrections.
- 2) Your paper must be **correctly formatted** (Papers must be a maximum of 4 pages long, in 2 column format and contain no headers, footers or page numbers).

- 3) Your paper MUST be **IEEE compliant**. All authors are required to use PDF eXpress.

- 4) Modified papers must be uploaded to EDAS BEFORE 20th September.
- 5) Please check your papers for typographical errors. If your first language is not English, please ensure that your paper is carefully checked by an English speaker. If **you are travelling from outside the EU**, you are advised to **apply early as visa applications can take considerable time**.
- 6) An author from each paper must complete a **copyright form**. IEEE copyright forms can now be easily completed online by following the link from your paper on the EDAS site (only after your paper has been accepted).
- 7) Authors are advised that at least one author from each paper MUST **register for LAPC 2009** for the paper to be included in the proceedings or on IEEE Xplore. You may register here.

- 8) Please ensure that **ALL authors are included in the author list in EDAS**. Please also ensure that the given title is spelt correctly and is the same as on the paper. Failure to do this will mean the authors/title will not appear correctly in the index of the proceedings and may not appear in IEEE searches.
- 9) All papers are **POSTER** presentations. Note it is IEEE policy to only include papers in IEEE Xplore when the authors have attended the conference and presented their work. Your poster should be A0 in size, in colour and in **portrait** orientation.
